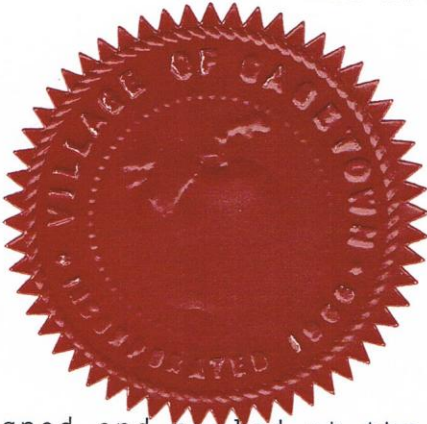


BY-LAW #23
NOISE BY-LAW

A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE DISTURBANCE OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE VILLAGE OF GAGETOWN OR THE CAUSING OF A PUBLIC NUISANCE THEREIN BY NOISE.

1. No person shall make, permit or continue or cause to be made, permitted or continued any noise within the Village of Gagetown likely to cause a public nuisance or otherwise disturb the inhabitants of the Village, unless the making, permitting or continuing of said noise is:
 - (i) necessary for the cleaning, construction or repairing of streets, the protection or preservation of property, or the health or safety of life or limb of any person or persons;
 - (ii) caused by construction equipment or vehicles of business and trade between the hours of seven o'clock in the forenoon and nine o'clock in the afternoon from Monday to Friday inclusive;
 - (iii) caused by residential repairs, maintenance or improvement between the hours of seven o'clock in the forenoon and nine o'clock in the afternoon.
2. Every person who violates any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$200.00.
