



# VILLAGE OF GAGETOWN

## Minutes

Date: January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 - Special Meeting of Council

1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Blaney at 6:00 pm. Present were Deputy Mayor Pleadwell, Councillor McNamee, Councillor Massoeurs, Clerk White and Assistant Clerk Hall.
2. Call for Motion to Approve Agenda: Moved by Deputy Mayor Pleadwell and seconded by Councillor Massoeurs to approve agenda as presented. With no questions and all in favour, motion carried.
3. 2020 Village of Gagetown Budget:
  - a. **General Operating Fund Budget:**

**MOTION:**

Be It Resolved:

- that the sum of \$1,081,428 be the total operating budget of the local government of the Village of Gagetown for the ensuing year
- that the sum of \$909,482 be the Warrant of the local government of the Village of Gagetown for the ensuing year,
- and that the tax rate for the local government be 1.4352

The council orders and directs the levying by the Minister of Environment and Local Government of said amount on real property liable to taxation under the Assessment Act within the local Government of the Village of Gagetown.

It was moved by Councillor McNamee and seconded by Councillor Massoeurs that the motion be accepted. With no questions to the motion and all in favour, the motion was carried.

Adopted this 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 2020 by the Council of the local government the Village of Gagetown.

**b. Wastewater Operating Fund Budget:**

**Be It Resolved:**

- That pursuant to subsection 117(4) of the Local Governance Act, the total budget for the Wastewater Disposal utility of the local government of the Village of Gagetown for the ensuing year consist of total revenues of \$66,475 and total expenditures of \$65,475.

It was moved by Councillor McNamee and seconded by Councillor Massoeurs that the motion be accepted. With no questions to the motion and all in favour, the motion was carried.
