## VILLAGE OF GAGETOWN Council Meeting Minutes

Location: Village Office – 41 Front Street, Gagetown Date: November 30th, 2021 - Special Meeting of Council

- 1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pleadwell at 6:30 pm. This meeting was held in person for council and via teleconference for residents. - 2. Call for Motion to Approve Agenda:

- 3. 2021 Financial Statements:
  - Sewerage Financial Statements:
    - i. Clerk White presented the financial statements for the year to date. There appears that there will be a small surplus at the year end 2021. However, Sewerage Fund owes a large amount of money to General Fund from years past. Any surplus will be used to repay a portion of this amount.
  - General Financial Statements:
    - i. Clerk White presented the financial statements for the year to date. There appears that there will be a surplus at the year end 2021. There are some projects/purchases that we can consider proceeding with before the end of the year. Any remaining surplus can be transferred to the General Capital Reserve Fund before the end of 2021.
      - 1. Council decided to proceed with the purchase of docks for a swim platform. Freedom Docks will supply the docks.
      - 2. Council decided to proceed with the installation of a heat pump at the Rec Centre.

- 3. Council decided to proceed with the purchase of two bunker suits for the Fire Department.
- 4. Council decided to proceed with a dump trailer and a new mower for the Public Works Department.
- 5. Council decided to proceed with the purchase of an electronic speed warning sign from Absolute Traffic.
